

Packing bench 1 instructions

How to construct packing bench 1 (no shelf) step-by-step

1. Your bench will arrive flat packed, with everything you need in the box.



2. Start with the black frames. Using a hammer, take the small black feet and use gentle force to hit the feet into the ends of the frame (the ends without bolt holes).



3. Turn the frame around so you are now working with the end with the bolt holes. Using the 'L' shape brackets, line them up with the holes in the frame. Make sure the narrow side of the bracket is in line with the front of the frame, with the wider part of the bracket facing outwards. Attach and secure with washer, nut and bolt. Use a spanner if needed.





4. Taking the tabletop, place it onto the frame and align the holes on the green structure to the 'L' shape bracket. Take the smaller washer, nut and bolt for the outward holes and the larger washer, nut and bolt for where the bracket meets the frame leg. Make sure to secure with a spanner if necessary.



5. Using a long bolt, carefully flip the bench on its other side and attach the back of the table to the frame.



6. Finally, to finish the basic structure of the bench, hammer the extra feet into the frame and then flip the bench upright.





Attaching the under-bench roll holder:

1. To attach the under-bench roll holder, slide on the small 'U' bracket with the 3 bolts onto the frame. Secure using the nuts and bolts provided.



1. Repeat on the other side. Once complete, the green bar can then be slotted into place.



2. Your bench is now ready to be used.
